With almost 200 active cannabis-related bills, tracking legislation can be daunting. That's why we're introducing the BioTrackTHC Marijuana Legislation Roundup – a quick roundup of all the current marijuana-related legislative progress being made in each state. Something we missed? Illinois

Illinois Senator Don Harmon is joining a growing body of legislators that are willing to explore cannabis as an alternative to opiates. If passed, the [Alternatives to Opioids Act](#) would allow people prescribed opiates to apply for a temporary cannabis card instead.

Michigan

A bill to require health warnings labels on cannabis products sold in Michigan was introduced last week. In addition to labeling, [HB 5222](#) would establish standards for cannabis storage, transportation, and maximum potency levels.

New York

New York [Governor Andrew Cuomo signed NY A07006](#) today. The Act will add PTSD as a qualifying condition for medical cannabis. The Congressional act to [eliminate the tax penalty](#) associated with cannabis businesses gained a new cosponsor last week. Ken Buck, R- CO, is the newest cosponsor bringing the total to 39.

Wisconsin

Wisconsin's bill to legalize and create a rulemaking committee for industrial hemp is nearing passage- [SB 119](#) passed through the Assembly with nearly 60% support.
