The general assembly of Connecticut has introduced an act authorizing and taxing the retail sale of marijuana. Introduced by Rep. Albis of the 99th District, [HB05111](#) coincides with [HB05112](#), which would permit the utilization of the retail taxation to fund substance abuse treatment, prevention, education and awareness programs.

A slightly bipartisan-backed resolution has been introduced, requesting Congress to consider legislation to de-schedule marijuana or otherwise allow the states and territories of the United States to determine for themselves the best means of regulating marijuana.
